2. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

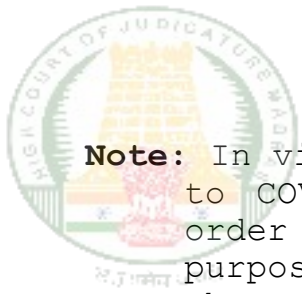
