This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to quash the proceedings in STC No. 229 of 2016 dated 26.03.2016 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Madurai District for the offences under Sections 188 of IPC and Section 4 of TNOPPD Act.
