This habeas corpus petition has been filed by the mother of the detenu, namely, Mari @ Maridurai, son of Pitchai, aged 20 years, challenging the detention order No.69 of 2019 dated 09.11.2019, passed by the second respondent, branding him as "Goonda" as contemplated under Section 2(f) of Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.
