PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.100 of 2019 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(CrI. Side) appearing for the respondent and the learned counsel appearing for the intervenor.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 120(B), 294(b), 420, 465, 468, 471, 354, 506(i) of I.P.C. r/w. Section 34 of I.P.C., in Crime No.100 of 2019 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.



3. The petitioners have filed two affidavits whereby they have given an undertaking that they will undo the wrong done in the offending transactions. The affidavits filed by the petitioners are taken on record.

4. The petitioners' counsel states that within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, the undertaking given in these two affidavits will be complied with.

5. Recording the said undertaking given by the petitioners, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Sattur, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with common surety for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
