PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail In Crime No.610 of 2019 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under sections 379 and 506(ii) of I.P.C. r/w. Section 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, in Crime No.610 of 2019, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.



3.The photographs produced by the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) clearly indicate that an attempt of illegal transportation of sand had taken. The petitioner's counsel on instructions states that the Tractor and Trailer involved in the occurrence will be surrendered before the Court below.

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4. Subject to this condition, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Srivilliputhur, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
