PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 139/2019 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences under sections 294(b), 341 and 506(i) of I.P.C. and Section 4 of Tamilnadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, in Crime No.139 of 2019, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. It appears that the petitioners had misbehaved with their professor, who is a lady. The petitioners' counsel on instructions states that the petitioners will write out individual hand written



letters expressing their unconditional apology and regret addressed to the said professor. The same will be enclosed along with their surrender petition. The Court below shall hand over the same to the professor through the respondent police.

4. Since the petitioners are students, I am of the view that their arrest will spoil their future. Subject to the aforesaid direction, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Kadaladi, Ramanathapuram District, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
