2.Recording the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side), this writ petition stands dismissed as devoid of merits. No costs.

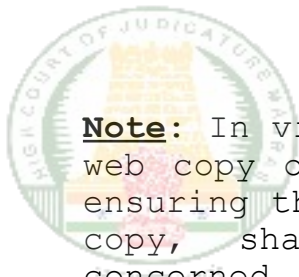
