

THE HON'BLE JUSTICE G.SRI DEVI

CRIMINAL PETITION No.91 of 2020

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition, under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., is filed by the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 6 seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.187 of 2017 on the file of the learned XV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Nampally, Hyderabad.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for respondent No.1-State and perused the record.

3. Though the petitioners have raised several grounds to quash the proceedings in the aforesaid case, learned counsel for the petitioners requested this Court to dispense with the appearance of the petitioners in the aforesaid case before the trial Court.

4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that since the identity of the petitioners is not in dispute, their presence in the above case may not be necessary on every date of adjournment.

5. In view of the aforesaid submissions, the appearance of petitioner Nos.2 to 6/accused Nos.2 to 6 in C.C.No.187 of 2017 on the file of the learned XV Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Nampally, Hyderabad, is dispensed with except on the dates whenever their presence is required by the trial Court and they shall be represented by a counsel.

6. With the above direction, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

7. Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending in this criminal petition, shall stand dismissed.
