ORDER:

- 1) The petitioner, who is accused in Crime No.161 of 2019 of Narayanapur Police Station, Rachakonda, filed this Criminal Petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the proceedings in the above crime, which was registered against him for an offence punishable under Section 307 of I.P.C.
- 2) Along with the Criminal Petition, I.A.No.3 of 2020 came to be filed by the second respondent to record the compromise. Along with the petition, a joint memo which is signed by the parties and their counsel, photographs of the parties and Photostat copies of their Aadhar Cards came to be filed. It is stated in the affidavit that at the intervention of elders and well wishers, the parties have settled their disputes in terms of the compromise.
- 3) Today, both the parties are present before this Court and they were identified by their respective counsel. This Court, when examined, both the parties have stated that at the instance of the elders, they have settled the matter out of the Court and the second respondent has no objection for quashing the proceedings against the petitioner.
- 4) It has been submitted by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor that though the offence under Section 307 of I.P.C. was registered, the second respondent has taken treatment only as out-

patient for two days and the injuries appears to be found on the body of the second respondent are simple in nature and both the second respondent and accused are uncle and nephew. Looking into the nature of injury; the period of treatment; relationship between the parties and in the light of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the compromise memo filed by both the parties is recorded and I.A.No.3 of 2020 is ordered.

5) Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is allowed in terms of compromise, and the proceedings in Crime No.161 of 2019 of Narayanapur Police Station, Rachakonda, against the petitioner are hereby quashed. However, the petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- to the Telangana High Court Advocates Association, Hyderabad, within a period of one week from today.

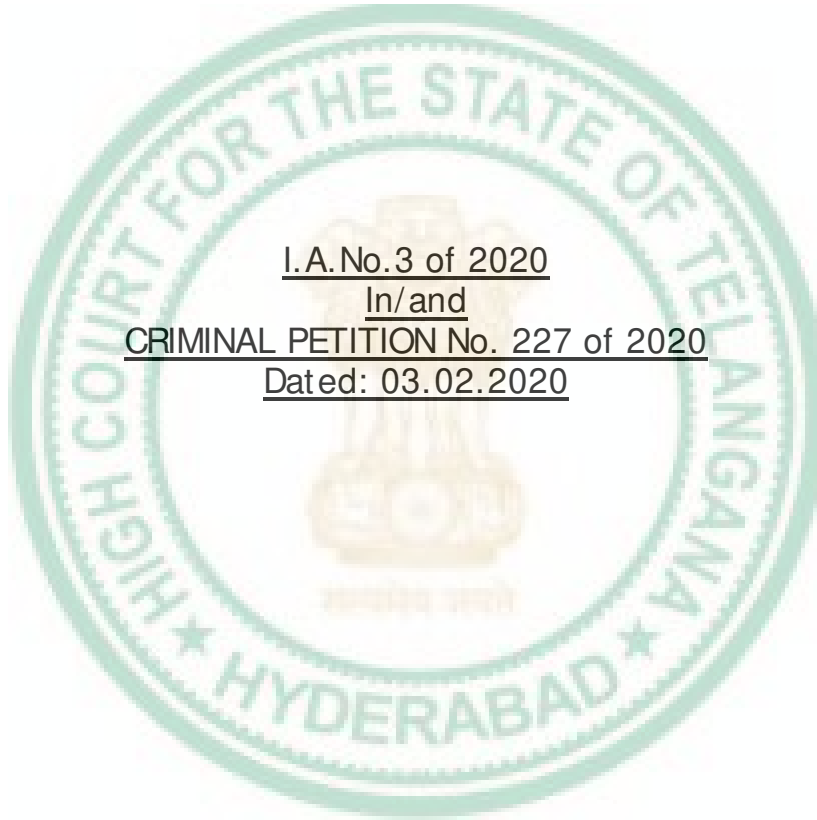
6) Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending, shall stand closed.
