

HON'BLE JUSTICE G. SRI DEVI
CRIMINAL PETITION No.361 of 2020

ORDER :

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of the Criminal Procedure, 1973, seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.402 of 2018 on the file of the XXII Addl. Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Secunderabad.

2. A charge sheet came to be filed against the petitioners/A1, A2, A4 and A5 along with other accused for the offences punishable under Sections 325, 506 and 509 r/w 34 IPC.

3. Though the present Criminal Petition is filed seeking quashing of entire proceedings against the petitioners, learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer seeking dispensation of the presence of the petitioners before the trial Court on every date of adjournment.

4. The learned Public Prosecutor submits that since the 1st petitioner-A1 is the prime accused and he has to represent the case on behalf of other accused before the trial Court, his presence may not be dispensed with. However, the identity of the other petitioners is not in dispute, their presence in the above C.C. may not be necessary on every date of adjournment.

5. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the personal appearance of the petitioners/A2, A4 and A5 in C.C.No.402 of 2018 on the file of the XXII Addl.

Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Secunderabad, is hereby dispensed with while permitting them to mark their appearance through their counsel, except on the dates when their presence is specifically required by the said Court. However, the dispensation of the personal appearance of the 1st petitioner-A1 before the trial Court in the above C.C. is rejected.

6. With the above direction, the Criminal Petition is disposed of. As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
