

HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A.RAJASHEKER REDDY

WRIT PETITION No. 1606 of 2020

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed for the following relief;

“...to issue appropriate Writ or any other order or direction particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondent No.3 in not renewing the Fitness of the petitioner's vehicle in spite of his repeated requests is arbitrary, illegal, unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondent No.3 to renew the fitness of the petitioner vehicle at the earliest and to pass such other order or orders appropriate in the case.”

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner who submits that the *lis* in the writ petition is squarely covered by order dt.10.01.2020 passed in WP.No.757 of 2020.

The said submission is not disputed by the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Transport.

In view of the same and for the reasons alike in the said order dt.10.01.2020 in WP.No.757/2020, this writ petition is also allowed in terms thereof, directing the respondent authorities to allow the petitioner forthwith to submit his application through online and process the same as expeditiously as possible and complete the testing formalities within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. However, it is made clear that the respondent authorities may take action

against the petitioner for furnishing the alleged fake address and getting his vehicles registered, in accordance with law. No order as to costs.

As a sequel to the disposal of this petition, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed.
