

HONOURABLE JUSTICE G. SRI DEVI

CRIMINAL PETITION NO.670 OF 2020

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of the proceedings in S.C.No.66 of 2016 on the file of the Special Judge Trial of Cases under SCs & STs (POA) Act-cum-VII Sessions Judge, Ranga Reddy District at L.B. Nagar.

A charge sheet came to be filed against the petitioners/A-1 to A-6 for the offences punishable under Section 3(v) of the SCs & STs (POA) Act, 1989 and Sections 420, 463, 468 and 506 read with Section 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Though the present Criminal Petition is filed seeking quashing of entire proceedings, but learned counsel for the petitioners/A-1 to A-6 restricts his prayer seeking dispensation of the presence of the petitioners/A-1 to A-3, A-5 and A-6 before the trial Court on every date of adjournment.

The learned Public Prosecutor submits that since the identity of petitioners/A-1 to A-3, A-5 and A-6 is not in dispute, their presence in the above C.C. may not be necessary on every date of adjournment.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the personal appearance of the petitioners/A-1 to A-3, A-5 and A-6 are concerned in S.C.No.66 of 2016 on the file of the Special Judge Trial of Cases under SCs & STs (POA) Act-cum-VII Sessions Judge, Ranga Reddy District at L.B. Nagar, is hereby dispensed with

except on the dates when their presence is specifically required by the Court.

With the above direction, the Criminal Petition is disposed of insofar as the petitioners/A-1 to A-3, A-5 and A-6 are concerned. Insofar as the fourth petitioner/A-4 is concerned, the Criminal Petition is dismissed.

Miscellaneous applications, if any, pending shall stand closed.
