Petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C, praying that in the circumstances stated in the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to release the petitioner/accused No.3 on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest in FIR.No.968 of 2019 on the file of SHO Jawahar Nagar.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri RACHAKONDA RAMAKRISHNA, Advocate for the Petitioner, Addl. PUBLIC PROSECUTOR (TG) for the Respondent, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is filed by petitioner/A3, seeking to grant anticipatory bail to him in Crime No.968 of 2019 on the file of Jawaharnagar Police Station, Rachakonda District, registered for the offences under Sections 448, 427, 307 read with Section 34 IPC.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner/A3, learned Additional Public Prosecutor representing the respondent-State and perused the record.

3. It is alleged in the complaint that on 30.12.2019 at 1800 hours, due to previous enmity, all the accused had criminally trespassed into the shop of the de-facto complainant, beat him with iron punch and also with knife resulting bleeding injuries on his head and mouth and they also damaged xerox machine, computers and glass of internet shop and threatened to kill him.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner/A3 submits that the petitioner/A3 was only standing out of the shop and he also stopped the entire quarrel and he informed the police about the incident and he does not have any role in the alleged incident. He further submits that the petitioner/A3 has been falsely implicated in the crime and he is no way concerned with the alleged offence. He further submits that the petitioner is a law abiding citizen and he is ready to furnish

sufficient sureties to the satisfaction of the Court and he shall abide by any condition imposed by this Court.

5. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner/A3, but conceded to the fact that the injuries sustained by the de-facto complainant are simple in nature.

6. In view of the nature of allegations leveled against the petitioner/A3 and other facts and circumstances, without adverting to the merits of the matter, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner/A3, by imposing some conditions.

7. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is allowed and the petitioner/A3 is directed to surrender before the Station House Officer, Jawahar Nagar Police Station, Rachakonda District, within a period of 15 days from the date of this order. On such surrender, the said Station House Officer shall release the petitioner/A3 on bail on his executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to his satisfaction. Further, the petitioner/A3 shall abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and co-operate with the investigating officer in investigating the case.

8. Miscellaneous applications, if any pending in this criminal petition, shall stand closed.
