and 21 of Constitution of India.
- ii. To declare the order passed by respondent no.5 (dt. 20/04/2017),
order passed by respondent no.4 (17/07/2017), order passed by
Respondent No.3 (dt. 16/02/2018), order passed by Respondent No.2
(dt. 01/12/2018), as illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Article 14 and
21 of Constitution of India as they are passed with zero application of
mind and with departmental bias and reinstate the petitioner into
service with all consequential benefits, attendant benefits including
back-wages from the date of suspension.
- iii. To declare the action of respondents as Unfair Labour Practice iv. Any
other order or orders, this court may deem fit and proper under the
circumstances of this case

affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the
Respondents to reinstate the petitioner into service with all consequential benefits,
