Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ or order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in not registering FIR on the complaint filed by the petitioner dt.31/03/2019 against the accused who are trespassed into the petitioner's land in Sy.No.24 to an extent of Ac.3.20 gts situated at Choulla Ramaram Village, Addagudur Mandal, Yadadri Bhongir District is illegal, arbitrary and in violation of principles of natural justice and in violation of guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case of Lalitha Kumari Vs. State of U.P. and others and consequently direct the respondents to register FIR against the accused who are trespassed into the petitioner's land in Sy.No.24 to an extent of Ac.3.20 gts situated at Choulla Ramaram Village, Addagudur Mandal, Yadadri Bhongir District.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents police to register FIR against the accused who are trespassed into the petitioner's land in Sy.No.24 to an extent of Ac.3.20 gts situated at Choulla Ramaram Village, Addagudur Mandal, Yadadri Bhongir District, pending disposal of the writ petition.

ORDER:

The present writ petition is filed to declare the action of respondents in not registering FIR on the basis of the complaint made by the petitioner dated 31.03.2019, as being illegal, arbitrary, in violation of principles of natural justice and in violation of guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Lalitha Kumari v. State of U.P.*

2. Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home.

3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, on instructions, submits that based on the complaint of the petitioner, a case has now been registered by the 3rd respondent authority vide Crime No.20 of 2020 dated 03.03.2020 under Sections 447, 468, 506 read with Section 34 of IPC and the authority has taken up investigation in the matter.

4. Having regard to the above submission, since a case has now been registered based on the complaint of the petitioner, the grievance of the petitioner in the present Writ Petition stands redressed and no further orders are necessary in the matter.

5. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is closed. No order as to costs.

6. Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
