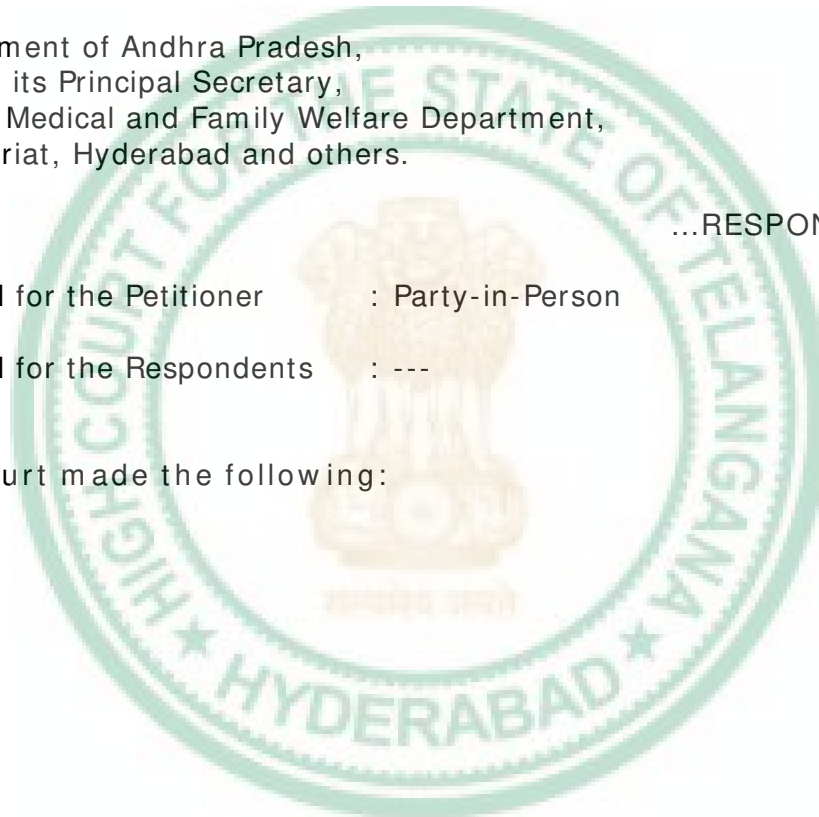

ORDER: { Per the Hon'ble the Chief Justice Sri Justice Raghvendra Singh Chauhan}
