

THE HON'BLE JUSTICE G.SRI DEVI
CRIMINAL PETITION No.1776 of 2020

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition, under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is filed by the petitioners/Accused No.1 seeking to quash the proceedings against her in Crime No.166 of 2020 of Malkajgiri Police Station, Rachakonda District, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 468 and 471 I.P.C.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners/Accused No.1, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor representing the 1st respondent-State and perused the record.

3. Though the learned counsel for the petitioner/Accused No.1 filed the present petition for quashing the investigation in the aforesaid crime, he restricts his prayer seeking a direction to the Investigating agency to follow the procedure prescribed under Section 41-A Cr.P.C. and follow the guidelines prescribed by the Apex Court in **Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar and another**¹.

4. Under these circumstances, the Station House Officer, Malkajgiri Police Station, Rachakonda District, is directed to follow the procedure laid down under Section 41-A Cr.P.C. before arresting the petitioner/Accused No.1 and strictly adhere to the guidelines formulated by the Apex Court in **Arnesh Kumar case (supra)**. However, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner/accused No.1 only till filing of the final report.
