ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking to quash the proceedings in CC No.776 of 2016 on the file of the XIII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (Mahila Court), Hyderabad, wherein the petitioners are arrayed as Accused Nos.4 to 6.

Today, the matter is listed under the caption 'infructuous matters' and when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, based on the e-courts case status report, would submit that after uncontested, the matter was disposed of as withdrawn by the XIII Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate (Mahila Court), Hyderabad, through order dated 19.03.2019 and as such, the present quash petition filed does not need any further consideration by this court.
