Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring, the action of the second and third respondents in not registering FIR, despite receipt of the complaint dt.10/03/2020 by the second and third respondents which was also sent on 27/05/2020 by Reg. post acknowledgment due as illegal, unjust, irrational and arbitrary and violative of the dicta laid by the Apex Court in Lalitha Kumari Vs.Govt of UP and others, (2014) 2 SCC 1 and to direct the respondents to immediately register FIR and take up investigation as expeditiously as possible.
