Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., praying that in the circumstances stated in the petition, the High Court may be pleased to relax the condition (iv) by deleting the clause (iv) 'The Petitioner/accused shall appear before the Station House Officer', Cyber Crime Police Station, Cyberabad District, on first Sunday of every month between 10.00 A.M. and 6.00 P.M. till completion of investigation, condition imposed vide order dated 20.11.2019 in I.A.No. 3 of 2019 in CRLP 2743 of 2019

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., praying that in the circumstances stated in the petition, the High Court may be pleased to relax the conditions (iv) and (v) imposed order dated 12.07.2019 in CrI.P. No.2743 of 2019 to protect the Petitioner's interests and to contest the pending litigation in NCLT, Chandigarh, NCLAT, New Delhi and Honble Supreme Court of India.

Petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C, praying that in the circumstances stated in the petition and the grounds filed therein, the High Court may be pleased to grant Bail to the petitioner/Accused No.1 in the event of his arrest in connection with FIR No. 430 of 2019 of P.S. Banjara Hills, Hyderabad;

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court dated 12.07.2019 made in CrI.P. and order dated 20.11.2019 made in IA No.3 of 2019 and upon hearing the arguments of Sri B Sreelatha Advocate for the Petitioner and of Public Prosecutor for the Respondent, the Court made the following

ORDER

This application is filed seeking to relax condition No.4 imposed by this Court in the order dated 20.11.2019 in I.A.No.3 of 2019.

Vide order dated 12.07.2019 this Court granted anticipatory bail on imposition of certain conditions. The condition No.4 is as follows:

The petitioner/accused shall appear before the Station House Officer, Cyber Crime Police Station, Cyberabad District on every alternative day between 10.00 AM and 6.00 PM till completion of the investigation.

Thereafter, the petitioner herein has filed I.A.No.3 of 2019 seeking relaxation of the said condition.

Vide order dated 20.11.2019, this Court modified the said condition as follows:

The petitioner/accused shall appear before the Station House Officer, Cyber Crime Police Station, Cyberabad District, on first Sunday of every month between 10.00 A.M. and 6.00 P.M. till completion of investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioner has been complying with the order of this Court since last one year and there is no allegation of violation of any of the conditions imposed by this Court.

On instructions, learned Public Prosecutor, would submit that the Police have not completed the investigation and that there is no allegation against the petitioner with regard to the violation of any of the conditions imposed by this Court.

Considering the above, this application is allowed relaxing the condition No.4 imposed by this Court vide order dated 12.07.2019, which is modified vide order dated 20.11.2019 is relaxed. However, it is made clear that other conditions imposed in the order remain unaltered. The petitioner shall cooperate with the Investigating Officer by appearing before him as and when his presence is required.
