COMMON ORDER:

I.A.No.4 of 2020 is filed by the petitioner/*de facto* complainant/respondent No.3 seeking permission of this Court to permit her to withdraw the complaint made by her in Crime No.249 of 2020 of Alwal Police Station.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner/respondent No.3 and after going through the affidavit filed in support of I.A.No.4 of 2020 and in the light of the report, dated 14.12.2020, submitted by the Registrar (Judicial), I.A.No.4 of 2020 is allowed.

Consequently, the criminal revision case is closed, thereby the revision petitioner/accused is acquitted for the offences punishable under Sections 376(2)(n), 417 and 420 IPC and Section 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 in Crime No.249 of 2020 of Alwal Police Station.
