Criminal Petition No.3707 of 2018

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking to quash the proceedings in CC No.950 of 2016 on the file of the II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Nampally, Hyderabad.

Today, the matter is listed under the caption 'infructuous matters' and when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, based on the e-courts case status report, would submit that after full-fledged trial, the matter has resulted in acquittal of the accused, by order dated 01.08.2019 of the II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Nampally, Hyderabad, and as such, the present quash petition filed does not require further consideration by this court.

Having regard to the submissions made as above, no further orders need be passed in the present criminal petition. Accordingly, the criminal petition is closed. However, the petitioner is at liberty to file a petition seeking to reopen the matter, in the event the said CC has not been disposed of by the trial Court as noted above.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this criminal petition shall stand closed.
