ORDER:

This application is filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking to enlarge the petitioners herein on anticipatory bail in Cr.No.1338 of 2020 pending on the file of Rajenderanagar Police Station.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that the above said FIR was registered under Section 174 of Cr.P.C. The 1st petitioner is the mother, the 2nd petitioner is the wife, the 3rd petitioner is the daughter and the 4th petitioner is the brother-in-law of the deceased. There is no allegation against the petitioners herein.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor, on instructions, submits that the police have recorded the statements of five witnesses, including the statements of father and sister of the deceased. There is nothing alleged against the petitioners herein. So far, the police have not shown the petitioners herein as accused in the FIR. Even then, the petitioners filed the present application with an apprehension.

4. Recording the said submission of the learned Public Prosecutor, this Criminal Petition is closed. The petitioners are at liberty to move appropriate application in

the event of Police showing them as accused in Cr.No.1338 of 2020.
