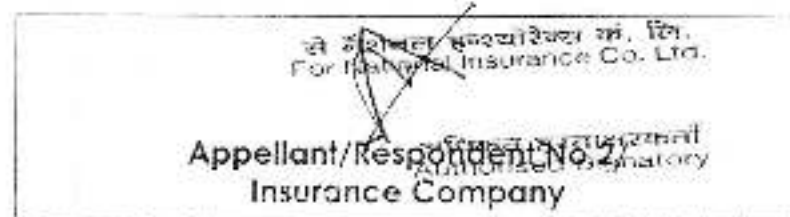
AWARD

The above case between the parties having been referred for determination to the LOK ADALAT and the parties having compromised the case / matter, the following Award is passed in terms of the settlement:

1. This MACMA arises out of the order dated 21-12-2006 in OP.No. 463 of 2003 on the file of the Chairman, MACT-cum-II Additional District Judge (FTC) at Adilabad.
2. The Tribunal has granted compensation of Rs. 2,25,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs twenty five thousand only) to the petitioners with proportionate costs and interest @ 7.5% per annum from the date of

3. Aggrieved by the order, the Insurance Company has preferred this appeal. In view of the latest Judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, and in consultation with the victim, the Appellant/Insurance Company intends to withdraw the appeal.
4. The Appellant / 2nd Respondent – National Insurance Company Limited, is represented by Smt. Sujatha K.Kumar, Manager, who has represented online over the link provided by the High Court Legal Services Committee, High Court for the State of Telangana, and she seeks permission to withdraw the appeal. Accordingly, the Appellant is permitted to withdraw.
5. In view of the above representation made on behalf of the Appellant/Insurance Company, the appeal stands disposed as withdrawn.
6. The Insurance Company is ready to deposit the remaining decretal amount with accrued interest after giving due credit to the amount already deposited, within (30) days from the date of receipt of copy of this award.
7. The parties are informed that the court fee, if any, paid by any of them shall be refunded.
8. No order as to the costs of the appeal.
