Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the impugned action of the 4th respondent in interfering with the possession of the petitioner and demanding the petitioner by threatening him to vacate the said Flat i.e. Flat No. 204, H.No. 16-11-740/9/7/204, Ranjeeth Towers, Dilsukh Nagar, Hyderabad, without following due process of law, as highly illegal, arbitrary and contrary to the principles of natural justice.
