WRIT PETITION NOs.16669 AND 16670 OF 2019

COMMON ORDER:

When these matters are taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the parties submitted that the issue raised in these writ petitions is squarely covered by the order passed by this Court in W.P.No.13164 of 2019 dated 03.12.2019 and contended that the present writ petitions also be disposed of in terms of the above said order.

In view of the above submissions and for the reasons alike in the order dated 03.12.2019 passed by this Court in W.P.No.13164 of 2019, these writ petitions are also disposed of directing the respondent authorities to determine the compensation in respect of the lands of the petitioners under the provisions of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 keeping in view of the guidelines of the Central Government dated 15.10.2015 and advise rendered by Telangana State Regulatory Commission to the Telangana State Government under Section 86 (2) of the Electricity Act, 2003, while awarding compensation. It is common that the respondent authorities forget about payment of compensation after laying of lines and petitioners have to run from pillar to post for getting their compensation by filing case after case, as such, the competent authority is directed to decide the amount of compensation, as stated above, and pay the same to the petitioners within a period of three

months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No order as to costs.

Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed.
