Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate Writ, Order or Orders, Direction or Directions to declare the action of the 1st respondent in refusing to cause correction of the State of Eligibility of the petitioner in the Application No.200410379103 of the petitioner for admission into the course of MBBS basing on the NEET (UG)-2020 from that of Maharashtra to Telangana, vide letter dated 03/11/2020 as arbitrary, unreasonable and illegal and to issue a consequential direction to the 1st respondent to cause the correction forthwith and also to direct the 2nd respondent to include the name of the petitioner in the State list of the candidates seeking admission into the course of MBBS (UG)-2020

ORDER:

Heard both sides.

2. The grievance of the petitioner is that though the petitioner is a native of State of Telangana on the ground that petitioner choose an examination centre at Nanded, Maharashtra, her state of eligibility is wrongly shown as 'State of Maharashtra' instead of 'State of Telangana' and her name has not been included in the list of eligible candidates for NEET UG-2020 for admission into MBBS course in the State of Telangana.

3. Sri A.Prabhakar Rao, Standing Counsel for 2nd respondent-University states on instructions that if the petitioner were to upload an application along with relevant certificates including the study certificates from Class VII to XII showing that she is a domicile of Telangana State, the 2nd respondent is willing to consider the petitioner's case for grant of admission in the State of Telangana on merit.

4. In view of the said submission, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing the petitioner to upload by tomorrow an application to the 2nd respondent along with all relevant certificates including study certificates from Class VII to XII, in

support of the petitioner's case that she ought to be treated as a student eligible for admission to the MBBS Course in the State of Telangana under local category. No order as to costs.

5. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending if any, shall stand closed.

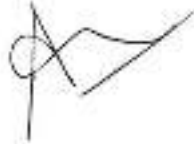
