Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondents in denying the just claim of the petitioner for awarding 10 entitlement points to the petitioner under spouse category even though the husband of the petitioner is working as Teacher in the same place / district and that the petitioner and her husband have not utilized the spouse points for the last (8) years, thereby defeating the chance of the petitioner for transfer and posting to nearby place of her husband's working place is as illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and violative of Articles 14 & 16 of the Constitution of India besides being contrary to the rule position and consequently hold that the petitioner is entitled for transfer from the present place by duly awarding 10 additional entitlement points under spouse category in addition to her normal entitlement points with all service and monetary benefits.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to award 10 entitlement points to the petitioner under spouse category in addition to her normal entitlement points for the purpose of transfer from the present place pending disposal of the above writ petition.
