Though this writ petition is filed challenging the order dated 04.03.2015 passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal in O.A.No.020/00523/2014, both the counsel would submit that the writ petition may be disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner in terms of the Memo No.17-01/2017-GDS dated 05.03.2020.

In view of the above submission and having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents / competent authority, to consider the claim of the petitioner in terms of the guidelines issues by the 1st respondent vide O.M.No.17-01/2017-GDS dated 05.03.2020, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
