ORDER

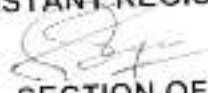
Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the cause in this writ petition does not survive for adjudication and hence, the writ petition has become infructuous.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed.

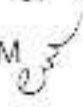
