ORDER:

The present writ petition is filed to declare the action of the respondent authorities in not registering a case, on the basis of the complaint of the petitioner, dated 16.07.2018, as illegal and arbitrary.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home.

3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, on written instructions, submits that, pursuant to the complaint made by the petitioner, a case in Crime No.612 of 2018 dated 16.08.2018 has been registered on the file of Sanjeevareddy Nagar Police Station and investigation is taken up in the matter.

4. Having regard to the aforesaid submission, since a case is registered and the same is under investigation, the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed and no further orders need be passed in this writ petition.

5. The writ petition is accordingly closed. Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall also stand closed. No order as to costs.
