Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in not amending the A.P.Excise (Grant of License of Selling by Shops & Conditions of License) Rules, 2012 and the A.P.Excise (Grant of License of Selling by Bars & Conditions of License) Rules, 2005, in consonance with the recommendations issued by the Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in relation to setting up of Liquor shops and Bars & Restaurants adjacent to highways as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 21 of the Constitution and further direct the Respondents to comply with the recommendations made by the Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in this regard.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant interim direction directing the Respondents not to grant any fresh permissions for setting up of Bar & Restaurants within 100 meters from National Highways & State Highways as per the recommendations issued by the Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, pending disposal of the above writ petition.
