Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 82 dated 07.05.2019 registered under Sections 380 and 411 IPC, at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar.

The case of the complainant is that at present she is residing at Ludhiana, whereas the theft took place in her house situated in village Rurka Kalan.

The complainant has specifically named the petitioner and others that they have stolen iron gate, iron gate of bathroom, iron box (peti), iron box (trunk) and other household items from her house and sold to the scrap dealers.

In view of the above, I do not find any ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, as the custodial interrogation is required to recover the stolen articles.

Petition is dismissed accordingly.
