In the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents No. 4 & 5, on account of their marriage which has taken place on 02.01.2020. The marriage certificate and photographs of the marriage have been appended as Annexures P-3 and P-4, respectively.

The petitioners are stated to be major, as the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is in the year 2000 and the date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 31.12.1999, as per Aadhaar Card and voter ID card (Annexures P-1 & P-2).

A representation dated 02.01.2020 (Annexure P-5) has also been filed with respondent No.2 in this regard.

Counsel has pointed out that the date of marriage and representation has wrongly been mentioned as dated 03.02.2020 whereas the same should be 02.01.2020 and the date of birth of petitioner No.1 has wrongly been mentioned as 03.07.2000 whereas it should be in the year 2000 and prays for liberty to correct the same.

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Ordered accordingly. Office to carry out necessary corrections/scanning etc.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State. Copy of the paper-book has been supplied to him.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and in view of the binding precedent of the **Hon'ble Apex Court in Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478**, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
