SUVIR SEHGAL, J (ORAL)

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.460, dated 14.11.2018 registered under Section 302 read with Section 24 of IPC at Police Station Badhra, Distt. Charkhi Dadri (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner relied upon the order dated 06.12.2019 (Annexure P-3) and the order dated 19.12.2019 (Annexure P-4) to submit that his case for grant of regular bail is at par with that of Anil and Mange Ram@ Leela who had been granted regular bails vide order dated 06.12.2019 (Annexure P-3) and 19.12.2019 (Annexure P-4) respectively. Still further he submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and is in custody since 07.02.2019.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the application for bail on the ground that the charges against the petitioner are of a very serious nature. He has further submitted that trial is in progress

and 06 out of 21 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

The case of the petitioner is similar to that of co-accused Anil and Mange Ram @ Leela, who have been granted regular bail vide orders Annexure P-3 and P-4. Moreover, there is no other case pending against the petitioner and he is behind bars for the last more than 11 months. No useful purpose will be served in detaining the petitioner any further.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
