The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 452 dated 10.12.2019, under Sections 323, 452, 506 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

The operative part of the order dated 07.01.2020, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that it is a case of version and cross-version and as per the FIR, incident had taken place at residence of the complainant and in the version given by the petitioners, it is in the fields, where both the parties are co-sharers. It is further submitted that there is a dispute regarding partition of the land, as the petitioners are in possession by way of mutual oral partition, whereas the complainant side claim is to be the joint land. Learned counsel further submits that petitioner No. 1 has sustained injuries and had undergone medico-legal examination.

Notice of motion for 06.02.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 07.01.2020, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Dharambir Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant submitted that the petitioners are extending threat to one of the relatives of the complainant, however, learned State counsel submitted that no complaint in this regard has been received from the complainant or his relative.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 07.01.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
