Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing respondents No. 1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No. 5 who is trying and making an attempt to forcibly take away the vehicle of the petitioner with the help of recovery agents and henchmen while it was running on road.

There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 22.07.2019 and 04.11.2019 and even today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 5 have placed on record the photocopy of affidavit dated 30.07.2019 executed by petitioner-Sukhdev Singh stating therein that he is unable to deposit the installments and unable to run the truck bearing registration No. PB-11-BY-1502 in question and surrendered the same. The photocopy of the affidavit is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondent states that now they are satisfied and the aforesaid truck is in possession of the Bank.

In view of the above, no further orders are called for in the present petition and dismissed accordingly.
