Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 04.01.2020 in this regard to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala.

Heard. Record perused.

Notice of motion to the office of Additional Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

The petitioners have placed on record only the copies of Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 to P-2) as proof of their age.

During the course of hearing, the petitioners have also produced

self attested copies of Matriculation certificate of petitioner No.1 and birth certificate of petitioner No.2, which are taken on record. Be tagged at appropriate place. Three photographs on one sheet as Annexure P-4 and a copy of certificate as Annexure P-3 regarding performance of marriage, have also been placed on record

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, to look into the representation Annexure P-5 dated 04.01.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
