Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 261 dated 27.06.2019 registered under Section 307 and 34 IPC and Sections 120-B and 201 IPC added later on and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Chand Hut, District Palwal.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was involved in the present case on the supplementary statement of the complainant which was recorded on 01.09.2019, whereas the gun shot injury has been given by Mukesh s/o Hari Kishan. He further states that the trial would take long time.

Learned State counsel assisted by Mr. Surinder Dagar, Advocate for the complainant state that the petitioner is a conspirator and involved the name of Mukesh s/o Rang Lal- brother of the complainant. On the instructions from ASI Virender Singh, learned State brought to the notice of this Court that challan has been presented and charges are yet to be framed.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and is of the view that the trial will take time to conclude and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
