The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.134 dated 05.04.2019 under Sections 341, 379-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Rohtak, District Rohtak.

The operative part of the order dated 09.01.2020, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that after registration of the FIR, the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and complainant Ramesh Kumar Badgujar has sworn an affidavit in support of the compromise (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion for 25.02.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 09.01.2020, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation. It is further

submitted that the complainant has already acknowledged the compromise in a petition bearing CRM-M-51771-2019, wherein the petitioners are praying for quashing of the present FIR on the basis of the compromise.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Jaswant, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 09.01.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
