Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.210 dated 06.09.2019 registered under Sections 363/366-A/120-B of IPC (Sections 376, 341, 323 of IPC added lateron vide rapat No.19, dated 16.09.2019) at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 10.01.2020 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation on 15.01.2020.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sukhwinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.01.2020 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
