The petitioners have prayed for the issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for directing the official respondents to implement the order dated 23.05.2017.

It is not denied that earlier the petitioners had filed a writ petition bearing CWP No. 4886 of 2017 which was disposed of on 31.05.2017 with a direction that “*the Gram Panchayat filed application for issuance of warrants of possession only on 24.05.2017 after receipt of notice in the present petition. As the private respondents have failed to adhere to the terms settled by this Court vide order dated 10.05.2013 passed in Ranjit Singh and Others case (Supra), the authorities to take appropriate action in terms of the aforesaid order, may be by taking coercive measures.*”

We are of considered opinion that once the direction has already been issued by this Court, the present writ petition, on the same cause of action, is not maintainable, therefore, the same is hereby dismissed as such.

However, the petitioners are relegated to avail their remedy of filing a contempt petition for the non-compliance of the order dated 31.05.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 4886 of 2017, if so advised.
