Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the impugned order dated 08.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur, whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender in FIR No.0066 dated 27.04.2016, under Sections 366, 366-A IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Mukerian, Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner undertakes to surrender before the trial Court and to face the trial in accordance with law. He further submits that even otherwise, the matter has been compromised between the parties and the petitioner has filed a petition i.e. CRM-M-50150-2019 (Ajay Kumar Versus State of Punjab and others), so as to quash the FIR in question on the basis of compromise dated 10.11.2019 and this Court had directed the parties to appear before the

Ilalaqa Magistrate/trial Court on 17.01.2020 for recording their respective

statements, in support of the compromise.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Ruchika Sabharwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

Considering the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the petitioner has also filed the petition i.e. **CRM-M-50150-2019** for quashing of FIR in question on the basis of compromise, coupled with the fact that the petitioner has shown his inclination to surrender before the trial Court, so as to face the trial in accordance with law, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders/appears before the trial Court within a period of seven days from today, he shall be admitted on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction. Petitioner shall furnish an undertaking to appear before the trial Court regularly during the pendency of the trial.
