Present petition has been filed by petitioner-lady Constable Neelam, *inter alia*, praying for a direction to the respondents to award additional 6 marks under the provisions of Rules 13.7 (4) (II) (9) of the Punjab Police Rules, 1934 as applicable to Haryana, for passing 6 months Computer Course, as per certificates, appended with the petition Annexures P1 to P3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had scored 100.25 marks whereas the cut off marks was at 101. Therefore, he submits that if the petitioner is awarded 6 marks she would be assured of having figured among the candidates to be recommended for the Lower School Course. He further submits that the Lower School Course is expected to commence after 10 days from today. He, therefore, prays for a direction to the respondents to examine her request which was made through the legal notice dated 26.12.2019 (Annexure P-7).

The Competent Authority is directed to examine the request made in the legal notice and decide the same in accordance with law within one week from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

Writ petition, is disposed of accordingly.
