LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in CM-12721-CWP-2020 is for preponement of the hearing of this case, which is listed for 27.01.2021. Prayer in CM-12720-CWP-2020 is for disposing of this writ petition in terms of order dated 29.10.2020 in CWP-6708-2020 and two other connected matters.

Notice of these applications was issued to the respondents.

Prayer in the writ petition is for quashing of impugned WAN Messages dated 13.06.2019 (Annexure P5), 19.07.2019 (Annexure P7) and 13.09.2019 (Annexure P8) being contrary to Rule 13.7 of the Punjab Police Rules (Annexure P10) besides quashing the list of eligible candidates under 35% seniority-cum-fitness category of List B1 – 2018 and for including the petitioner in the eligibility list and consequently depute her for the Lower School Course.

Learned counsel for the State does not deny that the matter is indeed squarely covered by decision dated 29.10.2020 in CWP-6708-2020, a copy of which is attached as Annexure A1. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“ All the three Writ Petitions are, therefore, allowed and the Respondent Authorities are now directed to include the admissible additional marks to which the Petitioners would be so entitled, for their having undergone the relevant Computer/Training Courses exceeding the duration of 20weeks in terms of Rule 13.7 (4)(II)(9) of the Punjab Police Rules, 1934, for the purpose of considering their eligibility for the concerned Lower School Course 2018. In case any of the Petitioners crosses the Bench-mark of 108 Marks, such Petitioner be deputed/permitted to join the said Course immediately, if feasible, or otherwise for the very next similar Course to follow.”

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as well as the specific stand of the respondents, hearing of this writ petition is preponed from 27.01.2021 for today itself.

Applications are allowed and the writ petition is disposed of in same terms as order dated 29.10.2020 in CWP-6708-2020 and other connected matters.
