Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0083 dated 08.08.2019 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 34 IPC (later added Section 326 IPC), registered at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurbachan Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 08.01.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
