Prayer in this petition is for issuance of writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* to release the detenue, namely Jyoti, daughter of the petitioner, who was allegedly abducted by respondents No.5 to 9.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Mahendergarh is on record and as per the reply, in terms of the order dated 7.1.2020, the detenue was produced before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Mahendergarh wherein she has made statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. that she has left the home of her own and has solemnized marriage with Bablu of her own sweet will. She has stated that her age is 22 years. The affidavit is also supported by a certificate issued by the Principal, Senior Secondary School, Pali, Mahendergarh showing the date of birth of Jyoti as 4.5.1998. The petitioner is present in the Court and she was sent before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for recording her statement. In the statement made before the Mediator, the petitioner had an interaction with the detenue-her daughter-Jyoti and the detenue has stated that she wants to reside with her husband Bablu.

In view of the same, no further action is called for and the petition stands disposed of accordingly.

Detenue-Jyoti is set free to go with her husband Bablu.
