In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 07.01.2020, affidavit of Assistant Director, Education Recruitment Directorate, Department of School Education, Punjab, dated 10.01.2020 filed today in Court is taken on record. In paras 3 and 4 of the said affidavit, it has been stated as under:-

“3.That in view of the above orders, it is hereby submitted that the office of the answering respondents will issue Roll Numbers to such candidates, who had earlier applied for the posts advertised on 24.01.2014 (645 D.P.E. And 25 Lecturer Physical Education), 17.12.2015 and 20.11.2015 for recruitment of 800 D.P.E. (including 645 D.P.E.) and 30

Lecturer Physical Education (including 25 Lecturer Physical Education) respectively but they did not apply for the posts of 873 posts and 74 posts of D.P.E. Master/Mistress and Lecturer Physical Education respectively advertised on 31.12.2016 (Annexure P-3).

4. That the office of the answering respondents has also decided to postpone the State level tests in pursuance to the advertisement dated 31.12.2016, which were supposed to be conducted on 11.01.2020 and 12.01.2020 for the posts of 74 posts of Lecturer Physical Education and 873 posts of D.P.E. Respectively till further orders.”

In the light of the above, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
