Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuing appropriate and necessary actions to transfer the enquiry/investigation in representation dated 15.12.2019 (Annexure P-10)

Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* submits that the petitioners No.1 and 2 are father-in-law and mother-in-law of respondent No.4 and petitioners No.3 and 4 are brother-in-law and sister-in-law of respondent No.4. He further submits that respondent No.4 and her husband Shakti Sharma were not having cordial relationship and pursuant thereof the petitioners are being harassed by the police of Women Cell at Panipat by calling them even without issuing any prior notice. Learned counsel for the petitioners has further contended that they have already moved an

application/representation before the Director General of Police, Police Head Quarters, Haryana, Sector-6, Panchkula and the Superintendent of Police, Panipat vide Annexure P-10 dated 15.12.2019, regarding which no action has been taken by the said officials.

Without commenting and observing anything on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Panipat to look into the application made by the petitioners vide Annexure P-10 and pass an order in this regard as early as possible.

The petition stands disposed of.
