This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by the petitioner for issuance of direction to the respondents, especially respondent Nos.1 and 2 to take action on the FIR No.0112 dated 14.07.2019, under Sections 307, 506, 341, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act (Sections 54/59 of the Arms Act added later on), registered at Police Station, Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

On 09.01.2020, learned State counsel was directed to find out the status of the investigation in the subject FIR. In compliance of the said order, status report by way of affidavit of Kanwalpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Patti, District Tarn Taran has been filed today in Court, wherein it has been mentioned that after enquiry, cross-case registered against the petitioner and others stands cancelled vide Rapat

No.26 dated 24.12.2019. It is highlighted that Kulwinder Singh co-accused has already been released on interim anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 13.12.2019 and strenuous efforts are being made to arrest the remaining accused.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition at this stage.
